It was caused by rats that were bitten by fleas that had the bubonic plague. The people in the time were not very concerned about personal hygiene and lived in filthy conditions which were conducive to the spread of germs and disease. There was no cure for the disease. The rats infected the people and due to their unclean lifestyle, the disease spread further. In a time where superstition was on its hey-day, the people believed that the disease was sent by God to punish people, or that Jews were responsible for the disease to spread. People died at such a rate that the undertakers could not keep up burying the dead.
