- Certified Copy of proof of residence

Notes and Instruction

- Shortlisted learners will be further screened by writing an Assessment Tests at a cost of R250, payable by the parent.
- Passing the written assessment test does not guarantee that the learner will be awarded the scholarship.
- Final selection will be determined by end year academic performance of the learner
- Scholarship will be awarded initially for one year. Renewal is subject to satisfactory academic progress and conduct during the year of study.
- Scholarship is only limited to one child per family.
- Parents will be liable for the monthly Fundraising fees (Currently R70 per month)
- Parents must ensure that the learner attends all school functions – after hours at own cost.
- Parents will be responsible for re-applying in the middle of every year for the following academic year.
- Parents are obligated to inform Kingfisher if their financial situation changes.
- Parents must ensure that the school policies and procedures are adhered to and followed by the learner. Failure to abide by the Code of Conduct may result in the scholarship being withdrawn.
