



# Kingfisher Private School Policy

## PREPARATORY SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

Should a pupil wish to be enrolled at Kingfisher Private School they must abide by the following rules at all times, **REGARDLESS** of religious, cultural or ethnic customs. Exceptions to these rules will be at the discretion of the Senior Management Team and the Board of Governors.

The following will apply during school time as well as after school as long as the pupil is wearing his/her school uniform. The following is also applicable at school events.

### A) Jewellery

#### 1) Earrings:

- Only one pair of visible pierced earrings may be worn by girls in the lower ear lobe (one in each lobe)
- Girls are allowed to wear plain gold or silver studs, as well as the school-branded earrings
- No sleepers, hoops, dangling or bulky/large earrings or earrings with stones or Diamonds

#### 2) Bracelets: Only medic alert bracelets may be worn

#### 3) The following may not be worn:

- Rings
- Necklaces
- Brooches
- Ankle chains
- Body accessories, e.g. nose rings, tattoos, etc.
- Hats or caps in the classroom
- Bracelets for various causes, for example, Casual Day (On any other day than the allocated day)
- Ribbons for various causes
- Badges for events not related to school. Note: Badges that are school related, for example, Science Expo badges, may be worn

#### 4) Watches:

- Only plain watch straps and plain analogue or digital watches may be worn
- Smart watches may not be worn

## B) Hair

### Girls:

- Hair must be neat and tidy
- Fringes must be above the eyebrows and may not hang in the eyes. Fringes are not to be “draped” across the forehead.
- Hair that touches the collar of the shirt, or hair that falls forward must be tied back
- All hair accessories must only be navy blue, white or black. No elaborate hair accessories, big flowers, bandanas etc.
- Girls are allowed to wear braids or cornrows, which must be tied up if they touch the collar of the shirt. The braids or cornrows must be able to fit into a swimming cap and stay on while the girls are swimming. All braids in the cornrows must be tied up with no individual braids separated from the rest. No beads may be in the braids or cornrows.
- Only shade or colour 1, 2 or 4 braids may be worn.
- Dyeing of hair is allowed provided that it is only one shade lighter or darker than the natural hair colour.
- Girls who have relaxed or braided hair may not use this as an excuse not to swim.
- Dreadlocks are allowed but must be tied back.
- Short hair that is being grown may have more than two ponytails until the hair is long enough to be tied into one or two ponytails.
- Hair must slope evenly upwards with no definite step

### Boys: Please refer to the attachment showing “Acceptable Kingfisher Hairstyles” for guidance

- Hair must be clean cut for at least 3 cm above the collar
- Hair must be neatly clipped around the ear.
- Hair may have one gradual step and the step should be all the way around and not clean shaven. The top of the hair must be of an acceptable length and easily manageable.
- No permed hair.
- Faces must be cleanly shaven and sideburns are not allowed to be lower than the centre of the ear

### Girls and boys:

- No wigs and patterns or “fashion” hairstyles.
- Hairstyles must be functional in terms of a school hat and swimming cap.
- No patterns may be cut into the eyebrows or hair.

**The parents of pupils whose hairstyles do not meet the Uniform Code criteria will be required to fetch their children from school. These pupils will only be allowed to return to school once their hairstyles are in accordance with the criteria of the Uniform Code.**

C) **Make-up**

- Make-up, including lip gloss, Vaseline or coloured lip balm, may not be worn by pupils

D) **Nails**

- Nails are to be kept short and neat
- No coloured or tinted clear nail varnish is allowed on fingernails
- No nail varnish allowed on toenails

E) **Underwear**

- The appropriate white or flesh coloured underwear to be worn when necessary. No underwear with pictures or patterns is to be worn.

F) **“Civvies Days”**

- **Non-revealing** appropriate clothing to be worn on civvies days
- No tops with big openings under the arms which show underwear are allowed
- No short shorts may be worn. Shorts must be mid-thigh or longer in length.
- No tops with low necklines showing cleavage may be worn, even if shirts or jacket are worn over them.
- No make-up or coloured nail varnish is to be worn.
- Long hair and braids must be tied back.
- No slipper slip slops allowed.
- No torn jeans to be worn on civvies days.
- Intersen Phase girls may wear jewellery and have their hair loose on civvies days.
- All headgear (hats, bandanas, caps, hoodies) must be removed during class and at line-up.
- On the days that “supporter “ shirts may be worn or the sport shirt at Spur evenings, blue jeans with no rips or holes and white takkies must be worn. The girls’ hair must be tied up. No make-up or jewellery may be worn.

**The parents of pupils whose clothes on Civvies Days do not meet the Uniform Code criteria will be required to fetch their children from school. These pupils will only be allowed to return to school once their clothes are in accordance with the criteria of the Uniform Code.**

G) **Clothing**

- Only the School Uniform as set out by Kingfisher Private School is permitted.
- The Sport Uniform is to be worn at all sporting events and during PE periods.
- On **Wednesday** the Sport Uniform is to be worn.
- On **Monday, Tuesday, Thursday** and **Friday** Formal School Uniform is to be worn.
- Formal School Uniform is also to be worn on the first day of every term and at final assemblies.

- **The school hat or cap is to be brought to school every day and must be worn at break time, no matter the season or weather.**
- Only pullovers, not jerseys, are allowed to be worn to formal school functions.
- Dry Macs, preferably navy blue, may be worn to school on rainy days, but must be removed when entering the school premises.
- During the winter pupils may wear a plain navy blue scarf, beanie and gloves. Beanies may only be worn before school and will not be allowed in the classroom.
- Unusual circumstances: If any unusual situation relative to dress or grooming arises which is not specifically covered in this policy, the HOD and the Principal shall have the authority to rule on the appropriateness of the attire. A letter must be handed in regarding any deviation from the school uniform. This will be valid for a maximum of two days, while the “problem” is sorted out.

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<sup>1</sup> No cycling shorts or long underwear may be worn under the shorts.

<sup>2</sup> The skort may not be tight fitting or lie at an angle in the front and its length must be four fingers above the knee when kneeling.

<sup>3</sup> The long blue pants can be worn in winter and only on unseasonably cold days in the summer.

<sup>4</sup> The school jersey and pullover may not be worn together. There may be no frayed edges on the jersey and no holes made in the sleeves for thumbs to be put through.

### SPORT UNIFORM: Grades 1 - 7

#### Boys and Girls

- School sport shirt.
- Navy school boxer shorts which must be mid-thigh in length <sup>1</sup>
- White sport ankle socks.
- Predominantly white track shoes/takkies. No ankle high takkies.
- The school cap or hat must be worn.
- School tracksuit. The top and pants must be worn together. Pants may not be worn on their own. The top must be zipped up.
- Swimming:
  - Dress

Girls: Navy blue or black full swimming costumes only. No other colours allowed. No revealing swimwear allowed. No tights may be worn under costumes.


Boys: Navy blue or black Speedo (long or short).

  - A school/black/navy swimming cap must be worn to swimming practices.
  - A school swimming cap must be worn when swimming in galas against other schools.
  - No slip slops may be worn to galas.

## SPORT UNIFORM

The Sport Uniform is to be worn at all sporting events and to Physical Education periods. All pupils participating in approved school activities are expected to comply with the dress and personal appearance regulations of the activity in which they are participating. Pupils who refuse to dress as required by the school will not be permitted to participate in the activity or to represent the school in any way. They will also be punished accordingly.

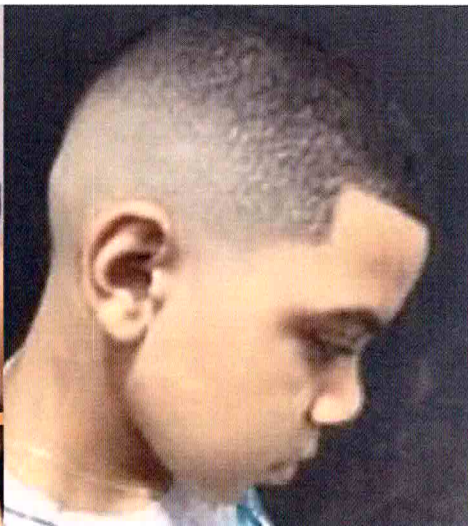
