FROM THE HEADMISTRESS' DESK

Thank you to all the Kingfisher Private School stakeholders who completed the OISESA surveys. We are grateful to you for taking the time to do so. The OISESA site visit will be from the 21st to the 23rd of May. The results from the surveys will have been collated by then. Some stakeholders might be asked to join focus groups during the site visit. The reason for this is usually because a particular topic needs to be explored more.

We appeal to parents, who have changed their cell phone numbers, to inform the school immediately. If your child is involved in an emergency, we will not be able to contact you. Furthermore, you are not receiving our regular and comprehensive communication, which is vital for you to be able to support your child and know what is going on at school. Educating a pupil is a collaborative and ongoing process. Some parents believe that dropping your child off at school and fetching them later, is all that is required. Our pupils enjoyed the event and gained valuable experience participating in the tournament. We look forward to the next chess tournament being held at Laerskool Tzaneen in May.








LIMPOPO ENGLISH SUBJECT CONFERENCE 2024 - STANFORD LAKE COLLEGE



The annual Limpopo English Conference was held on Saturday the 20th of April at Stanford Lake College. The conference is a gathering of IEB English teachers in Limpopo and is hosted by the English department staff at Stanford Lake college. This year, the focus was on Gr 12 and our FET English teacher, Miss Hlungwani attended the event. Among the highlights were discussions on the Grade 12 English set works (Shakespeare's Othello and the prescribed novels), the Common Assessment Task for 2024, and the exploration of Film Study as the 4th Genre.

- 1. Grade 12 English Set Works: With an emphasis on literary analysis and critical engagement, teachers had the opportunity to delve deep into the prescribed set works for Grade 12 English. These discussions provided valuable insights into the themes, characters, and stylistic elements of the selected texts, equipping teachers with the tools to guide pupils through a profound understanding and appreciation of literature.
- **2. Common Assessment Task for 2024**: Teachers received updates on the CAT for 2024, including approaches to assessment methodologies and strategies for fostering comprehensive literacy skills among pupils.
- **3. Film Study/4th Genre:** The conference explored the integration of Film Study as a dynamic component of English assessments. By embracing film as the 4th Genre, teachers can engage pupils in multidimensional analyses, encouraging them to dissect visual narratives with the same rigour applied to traditional literary texts.

Through collaborative exchanges and thought-provoking sessions, the English Subject Conference at Stanford Lake College inspired and empowered teachers to implement new instruction strategies, foster a love for language that transcends the confines of the classroom, and inspire the pupils to become articulate communicators and critical thinkers.


